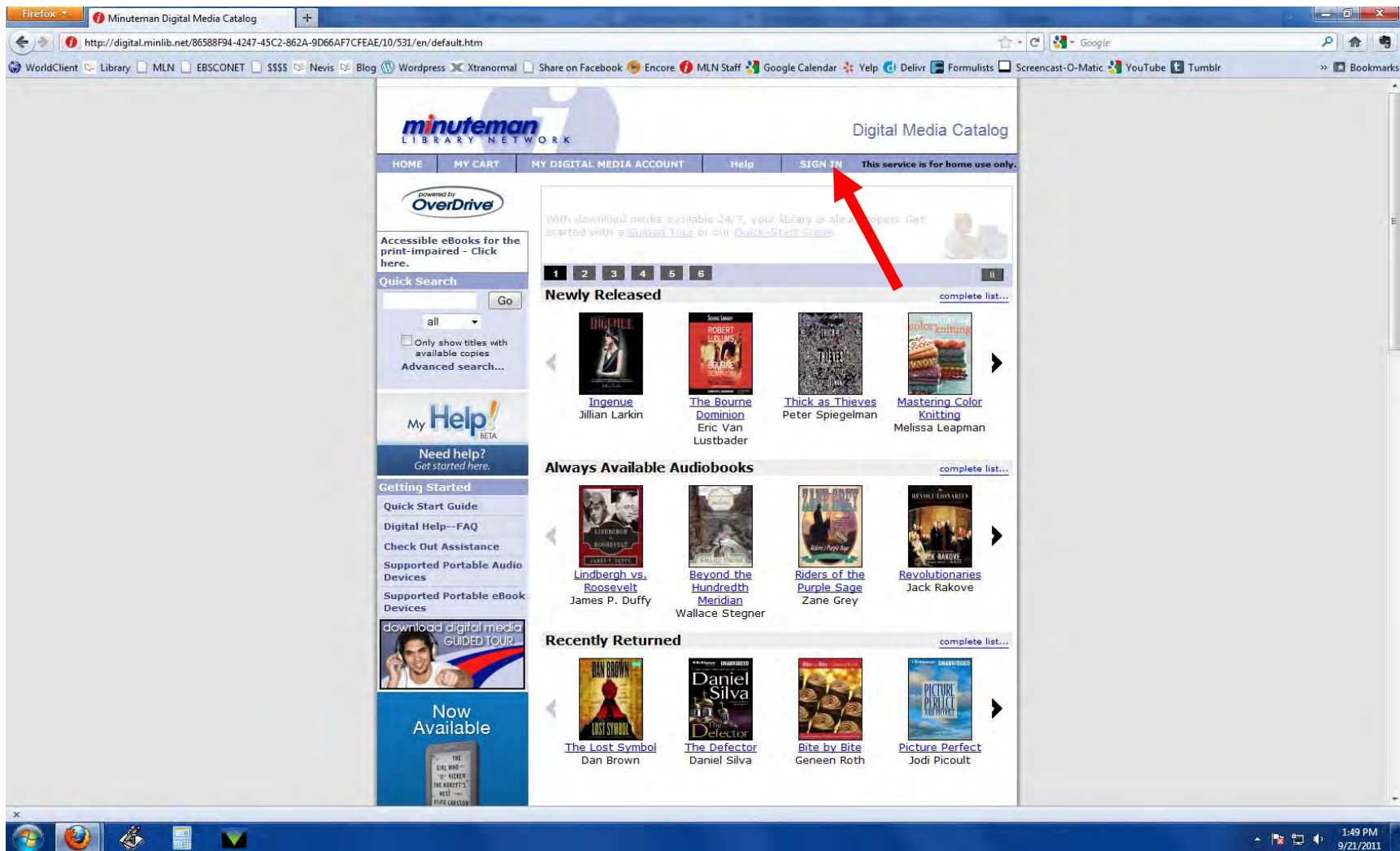

1. Open an internet browser and go to the Digital Media Catalog website: <http://digital.minilib.net>.
2. Click on the "SIGN IN" tab at the top right corner of the page.

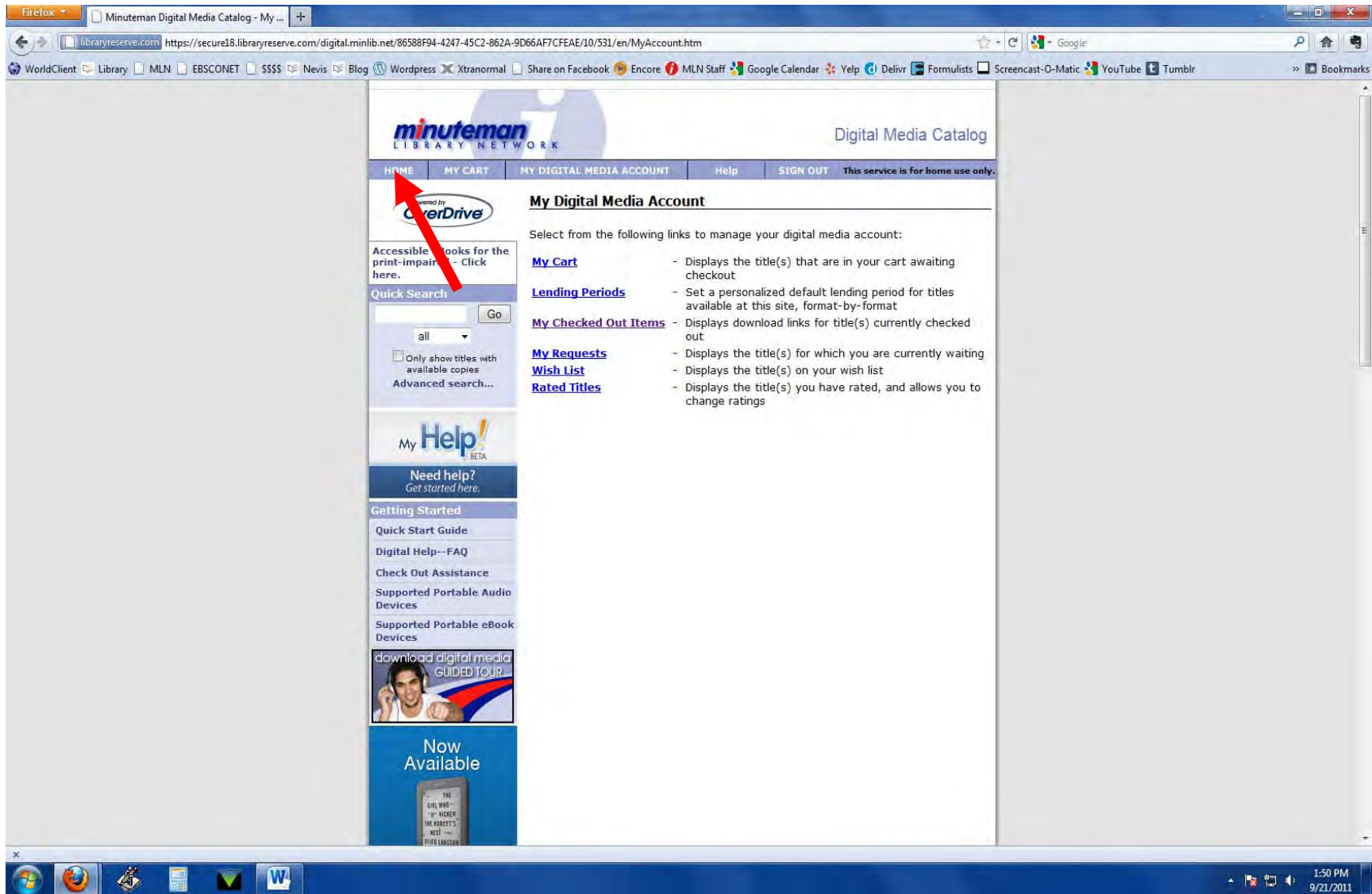

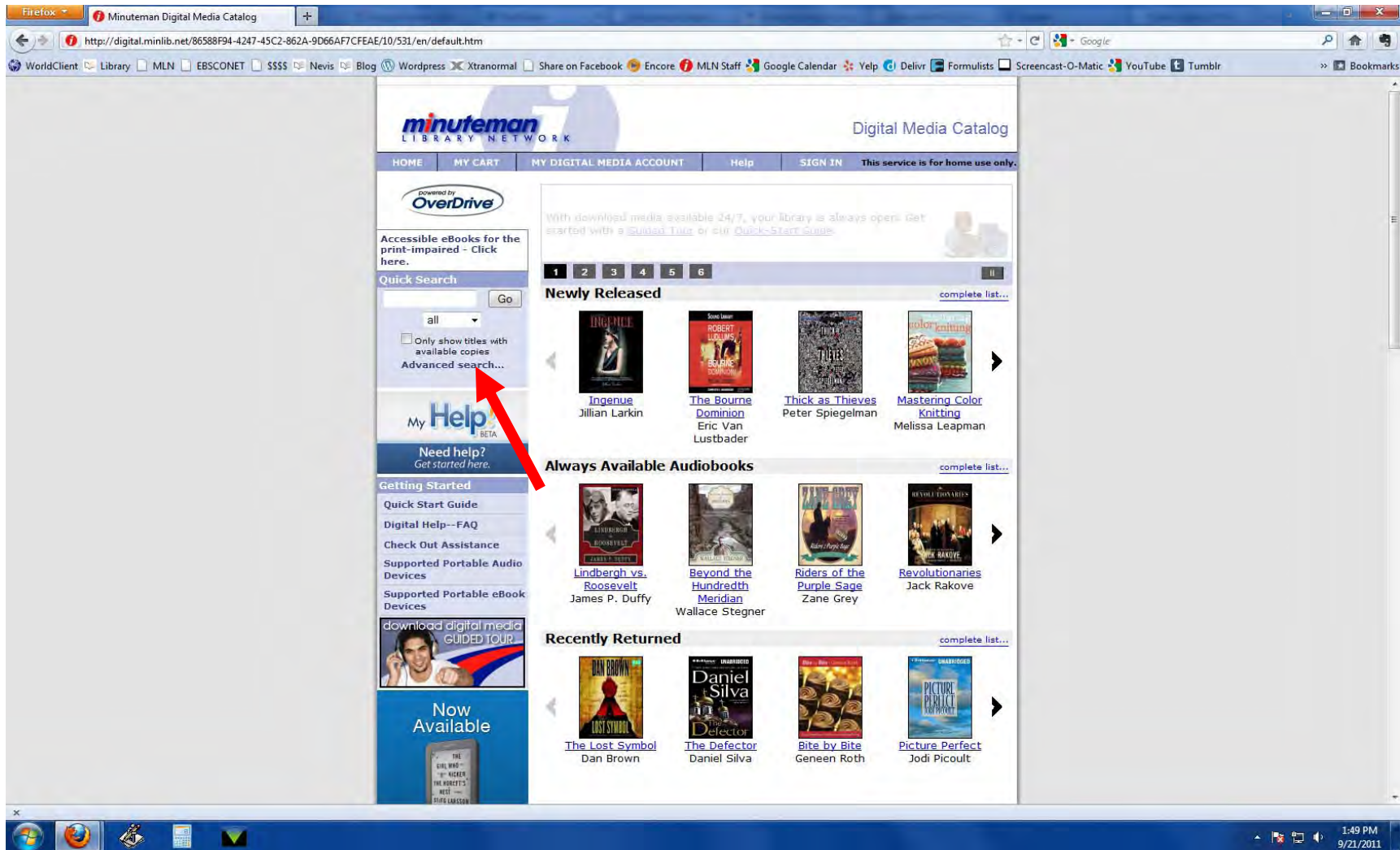

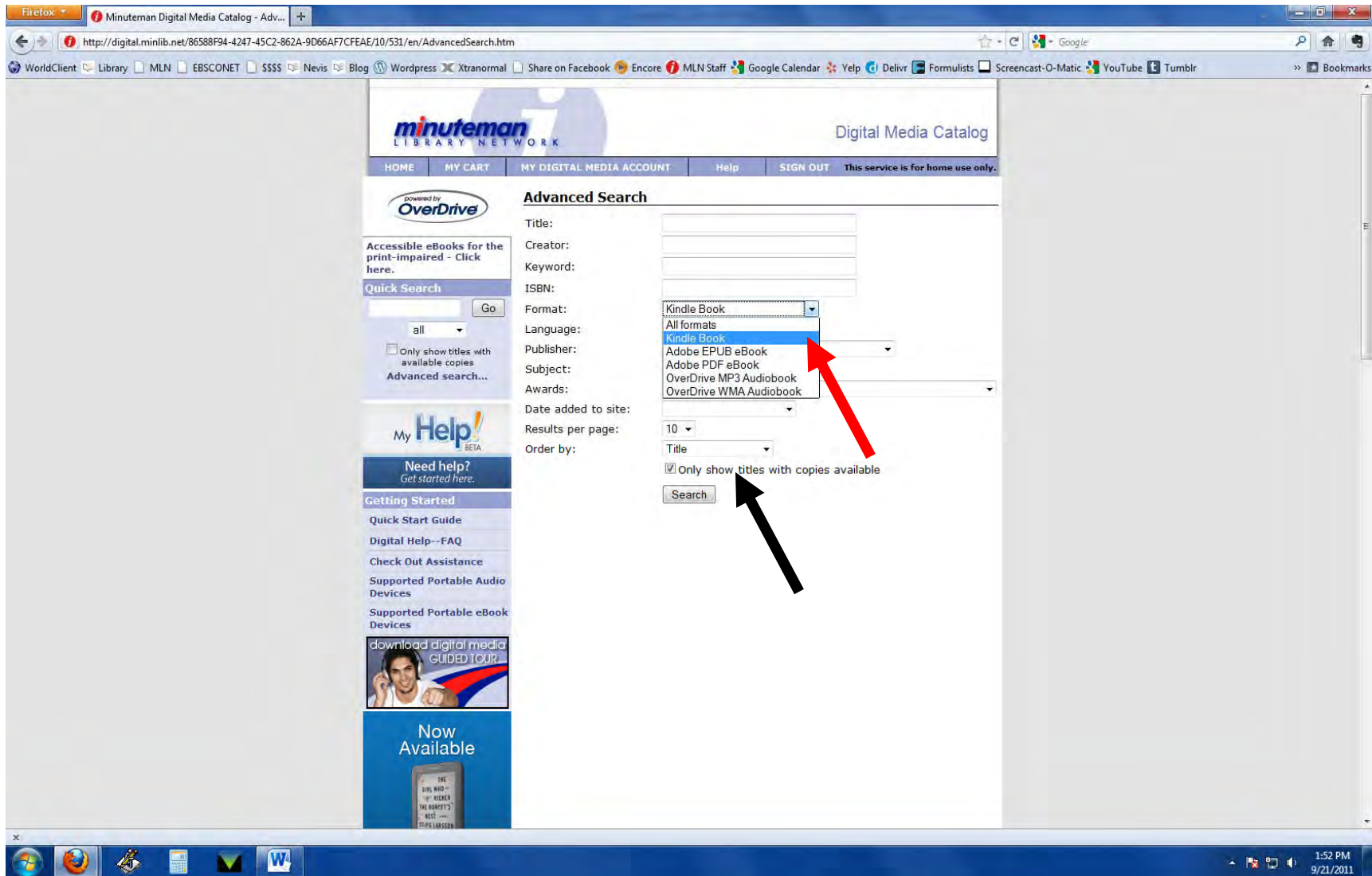
3. Type your Minuteman Library Network library card number with no spaces, then your MLN PIN. (If you don't have a PIN, you may establish one by going to MY ACCOUNT at the MLN catalog : <https://library.minlib.net/patroninfo/>).



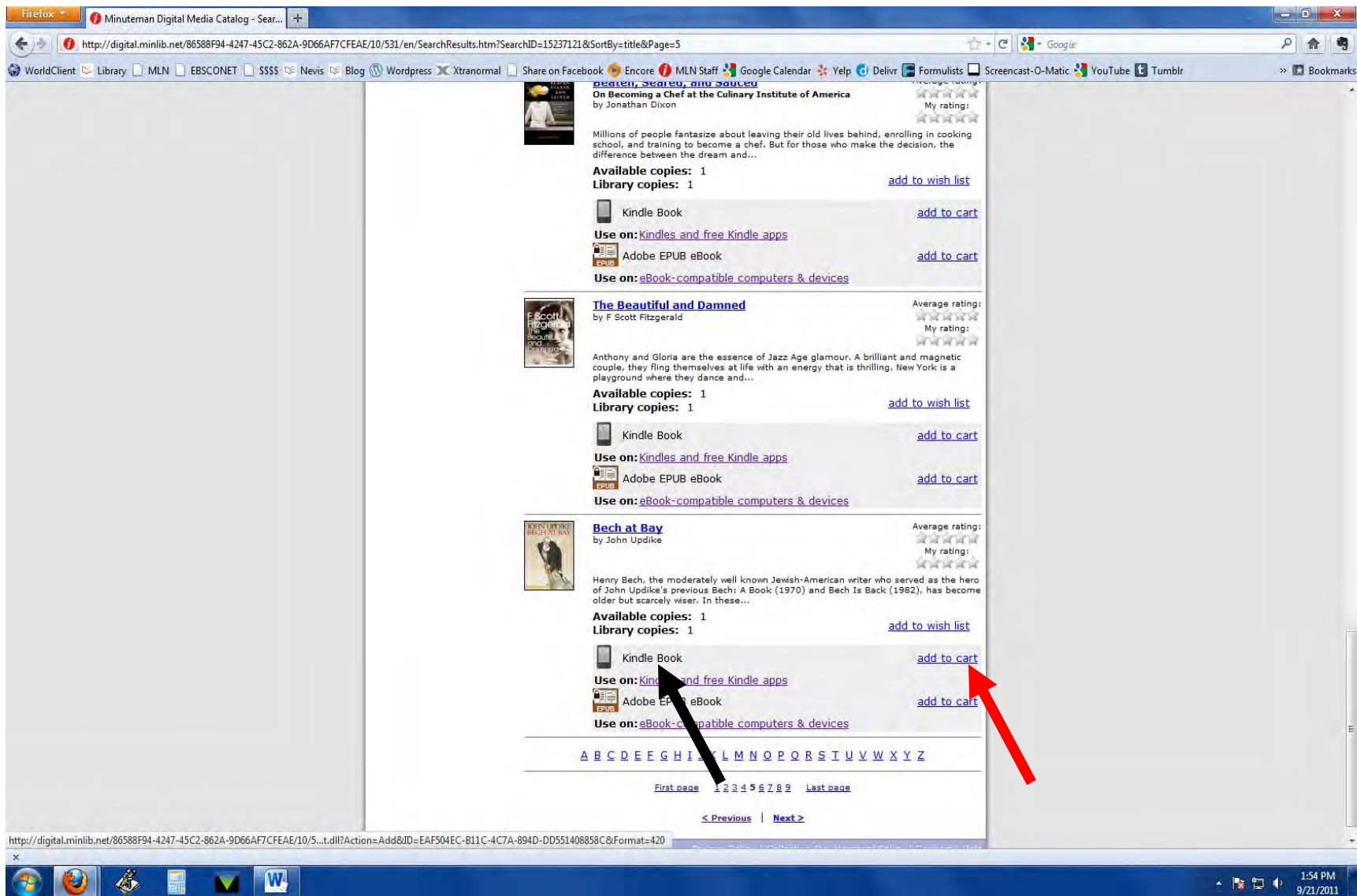
4. Successfully entering your card number and PIN will bring you to the My Digital Media Account page. To browse for titles to read, click on the "HOME" tab.



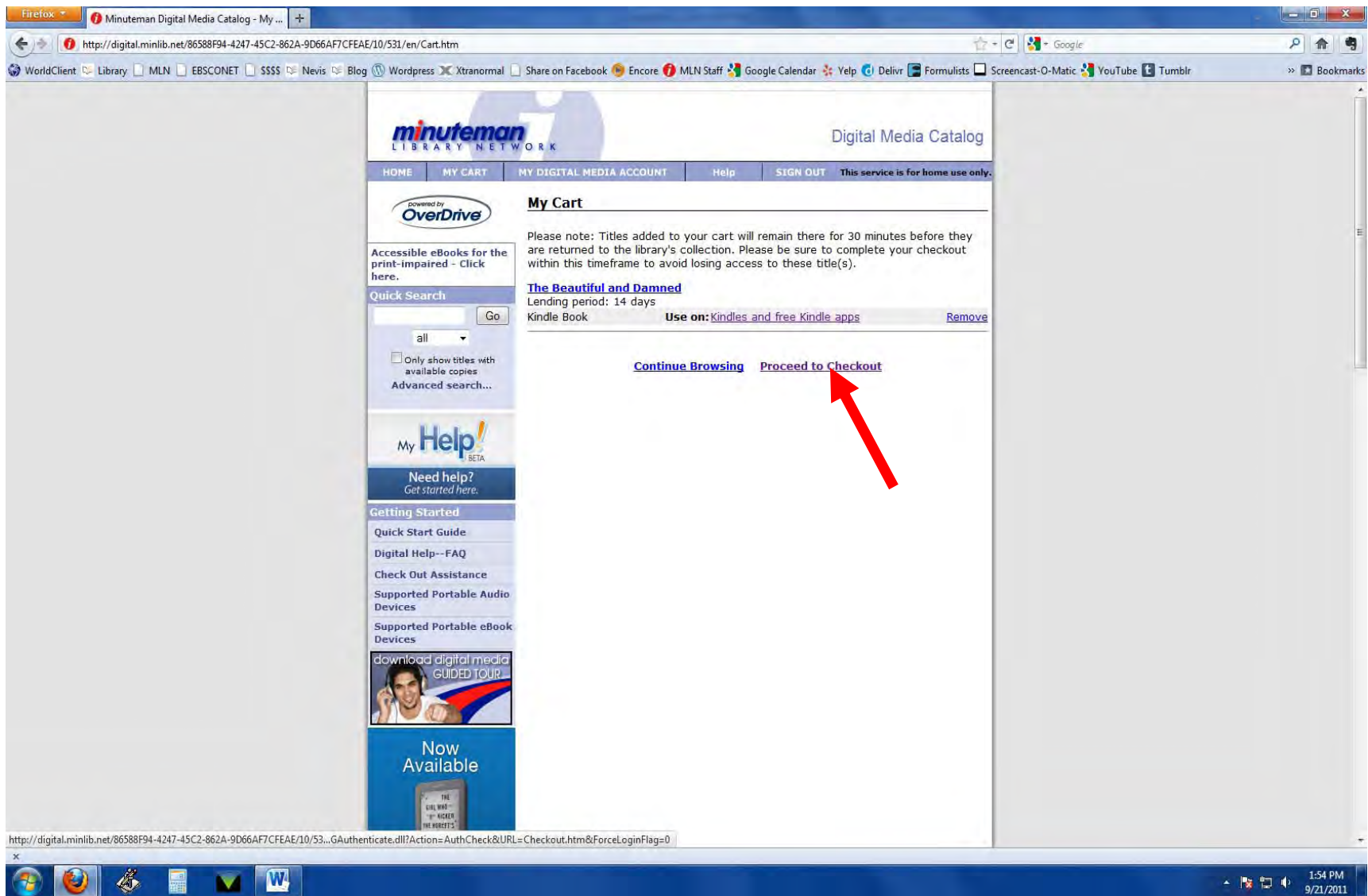
5. Familiarize yourself with the different ways to browse on the front page of the Digital Media Catalog. To find ebooks available to check out immediately, click on the "Advanced Search" link.



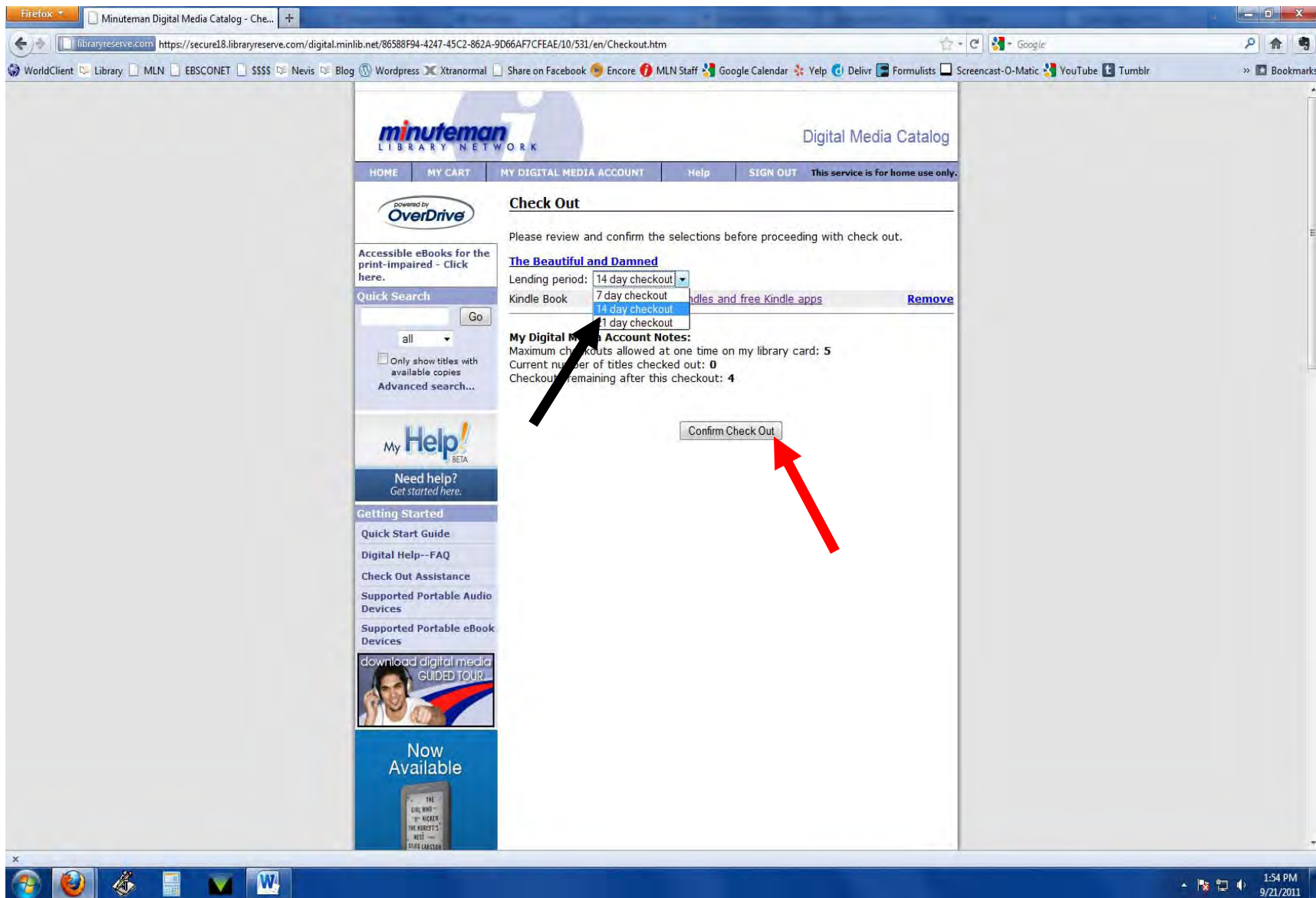
6. On the Format drop-down menu, choose Kindle Book (red arrow). To refine your search further, you may also enter information into the fields above, or select choices from other drop-down menus.
7. Click the check box (black arrow) to show only available ebooks. Click "Search."



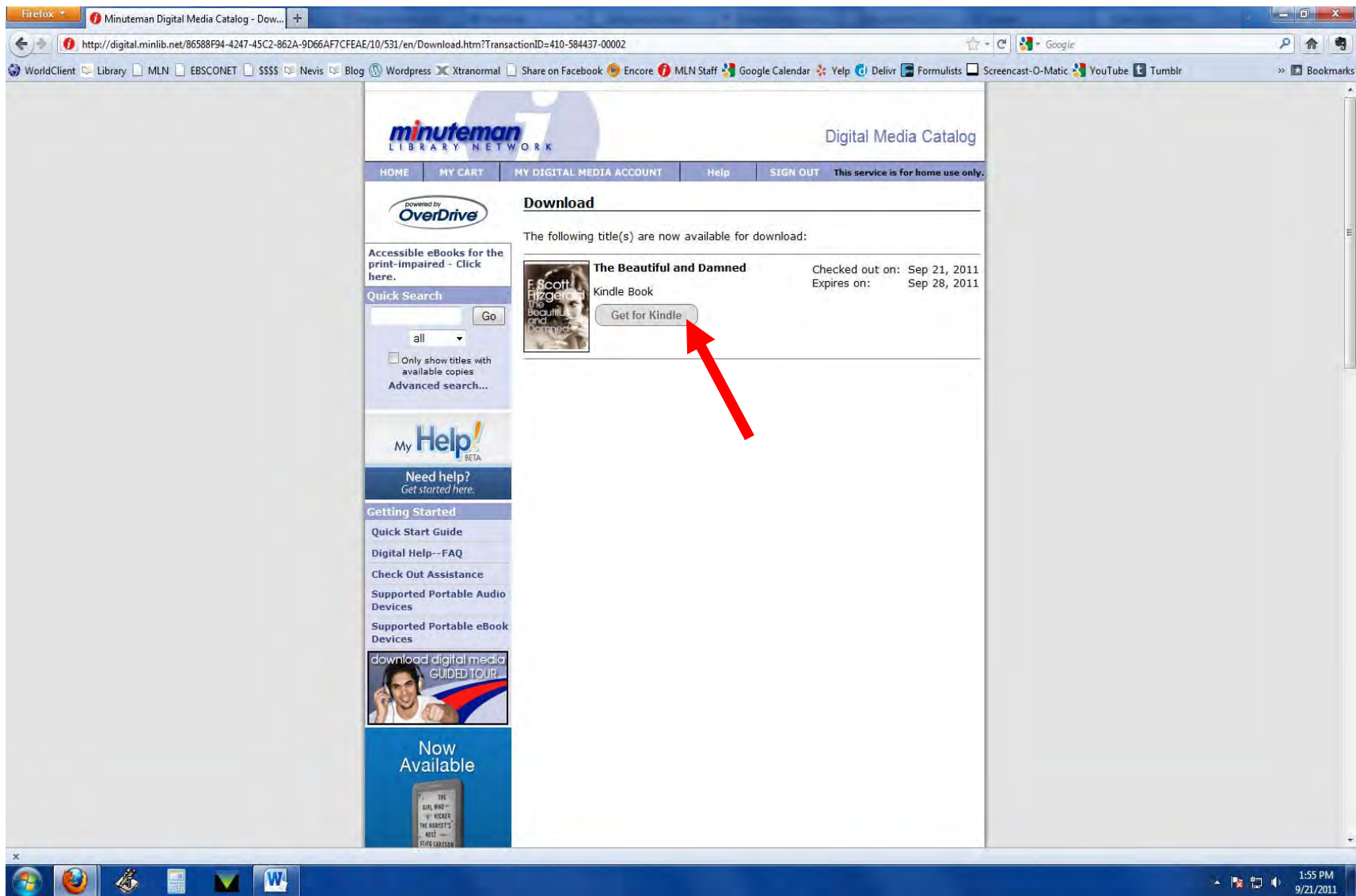
8. Scroll through the results. Notice that each record includes the notation "Kindle Book" (black arrow). To start the checkout process, click on "add to cart" (red arrow). Make sure to click on the "add to cart" that is paired with "Kindle Book."



9. Click on "Proceed to Checkout."



10. Choose your checkout period (black arrow), then click "Confirm Checkout" (red arrow).




11. Click on "Get for Kindle." This will take you to an Amazon.com page.

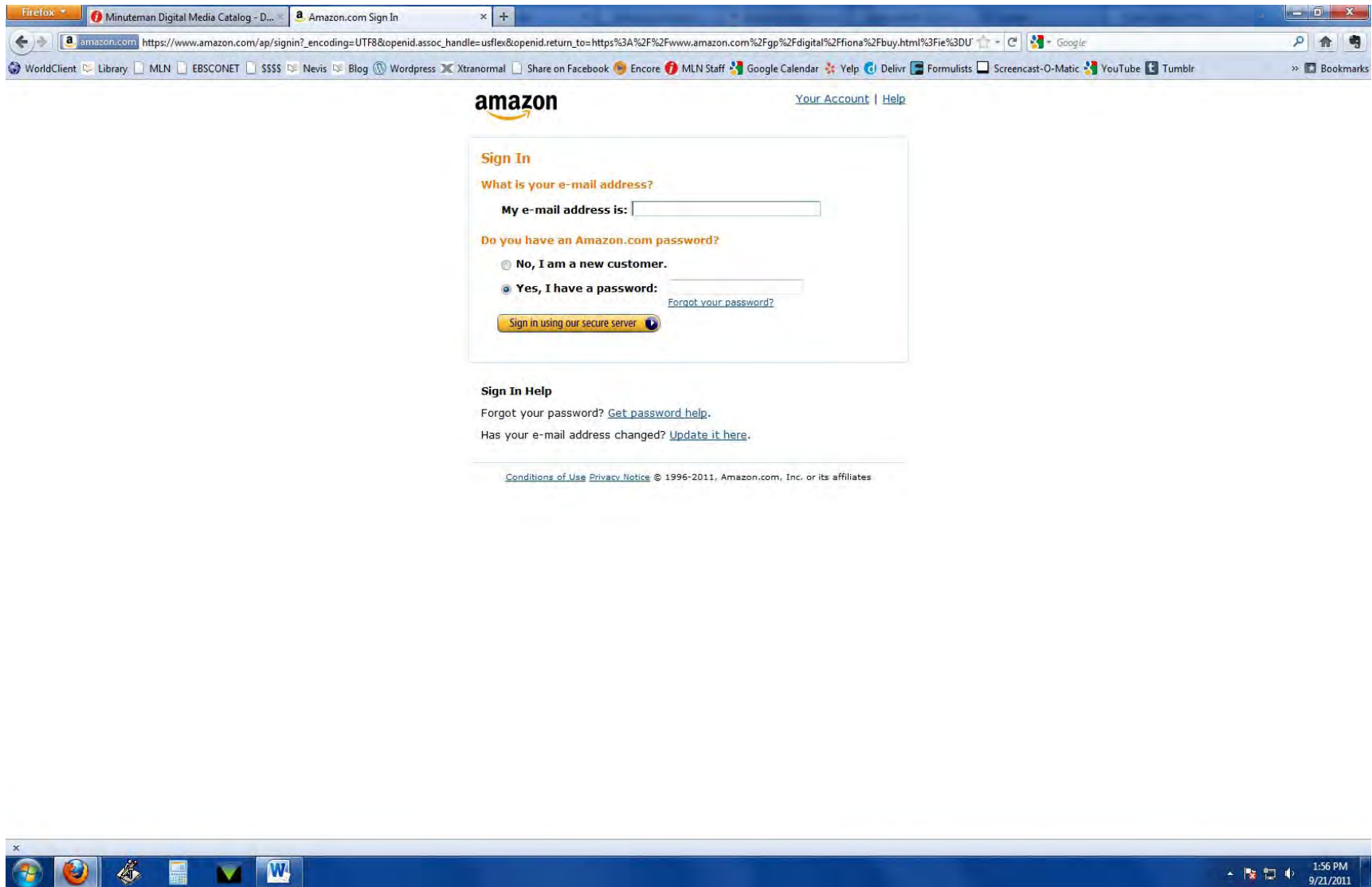

13. If you have an Amazon account, enter your email address and password. If you do not have an Amazon account, enter your email address and click on the radio button next to “No, I am a new customer.” Click “Sign in using our secure server.”
